COVID-19 Policies

- All children and volunteers will have their temperature checked upon arrival each day.
- Rotations have been arranged to optimize social distancing.
- Class sizes have split in half.
- Each class will be required to use hand sanitizer at every rotation.
- The church will be deep cleaned every day after VBS.
- Mesa Christian Fellowship will continue to monitor current executive orders so that we can be sure to adhere to whatever laws are in place during the week of VBS.

Note:

During our VBS we will not be requiring or providing masks. We feel that seeing one another's faces is an important aspect of our children's ministry here at Mesa Christian Fellowship. Kids need to see the teacher's expressions as they tell Bible stories, they need to see the joy on the face of those leading worship, and they need to see the smiles on one another's faces. If individual teachers and volunteers would like to wear a mask, we will leave that decision up to them. Additionally, if you bring your child to VBS with a mask on, we will make sure the mask remains on throughout the day. But please do not bring your child to VBS with the expectation that everyone will be wearing a mask, because many will not.

VBS PROCEDURES

Every Day:

- Front Doors will not open for registration and drop off until 8:45 am (8:30 am the first day), and won't be opened for pick up until 12:30 pm.
- There will people dedicated exclusively for the Safety Team during the working hours of VBS
- The parent/guardian/other will sign in and sign out their child/children. (see sign in and sign out procedures below)
- All the doors will be monitored or locked during working hours, this includes the front door.
- The age range for VBS is 4 year olds through going into 6th graders, NO 3 year olds or under.
- Everyone will enter and exit through the front door ONLY!
- No adults, youth or kids will be letting anyone in the building unless otherwise told.
- The only adults/youth allowed in the building during VBS working hours are approved Volunteers. To be an approved Volunteer you had to pass a background check and attend the Mesa Christian VBS Volunteer Training.

Start of Day/Sign In Procedures:

- The kids must be accompanied by an adult for sign in.
- All kids must be registered or signed in before the parent/guardian/other can leave
- After the first day students will be signed in at the door, if they are not on the list then they must be registered.
- If the child has a food allergy the parent/guardian/other must fill out an allergy bracelet before entering (EVERYDAY).

End of the Day/Sign Out Procedures:

- Only parent/guardian/other on our list will be allowed to pick up their students. (MUST HAVE PHOTO ID!!)
- The parent/guardian/other will sign their child/children out at the door.
